4) The minutes of the previous Meeting were read, agreed and signed.

5) Captains Report

Mr Rawlings said that once again there had been a struggle to get players, with subsequent inconsistency in the seasons' results. J Evans had had a very good run. Stuart Silkstone was consistent as ever and had bowled well. After the first three players (referring to the bowling and batting figures handed round prior to the meeting by Mr S Buy) on the averages list, some of the performances had been poor. Mr Rawlings said that the teams had bowled reasonably well but had not got the runs. New blood is needed, he added.

6) Treasurers Report

(Copies of the Accounts having been passed around). Mr Silkstone said that without sponsorship the club's finances would be in a sorry state. Membership monies down by £100 on last year; £78 outstanding to be paid. Nets cost £60 annually; only a fraction of this had been collected in as the turnout had been poor. It was agreed that they go up to £1 per session. A discussion followed on the matter of the match fees. M Mears proposed a membership fee of £12 with a match fee of £2; seconded by Stuart Silkstone; motion carried. (Membership fee applies 5 games or over). It was agreed that juniors would have to stay at £5 plus 50 pence match fee. (Under 16 years or undertaking full time education. ●●●●●●●●) The Chairman pointed out that Insurance carried by the club does not cover members for personal injury, odd day players paying subs are members for the day. Mr Silkstone further stressed that it was essential for the match captains to complete the match cards and return them to him. Accurate accounts depend upon this. It was agreed that the Grand National draw would go ahead this year but the club would not compete in the evening league. ●●●●●●●● Richard Crewe Reed, Martin Mears and Tony Watson kindly agreed to continue sponsoring the club. Mr Watson proposed the accounts be adopted, Mr K Ashwell seconded. The motion was carried.
